

How to create documentation for your OPNFV project

this is the directory structure of the docs/ directory that can be found in the root of your project directory

```
./etc
./etc/opnfv-logo.png
./etc/conf.py
./how-to-use-docs
./how-to-use-docs/documentation-example.rst
./how-to-use-docs/index.rst
```

To create your own documentation, Create any number of directories (depending on your need) and place in each of them an index.rst. This index file must reference your other rst files.

- Here is an example index.rst

The Sphinx Build

When you push documentation changes to gerrit a jenkins job will create html documentation.

- Verify Jobs

For verify jobs a link to the documentation will show up as a comment in gerrit for you to see the result.

- Merge jobs

Once you are happy with the look of your documentation you can submit the patchset the merge job will copy the output of each documentation directory to [http://artifacts.opnfv.org/\\$project/docs/\\$name_of_your_folder/index.html](http://artifacts.opnfv.org/$project/docs/$name_of_your_folder/index.html)
